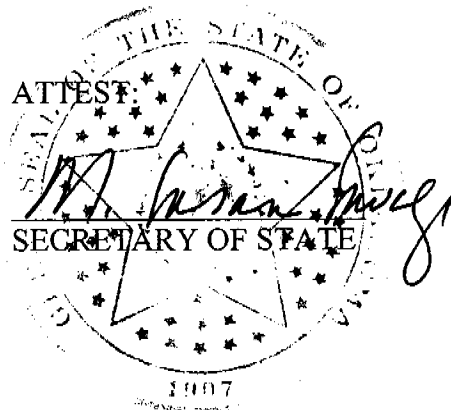
Monday	January 1, 2007	New Year's Day

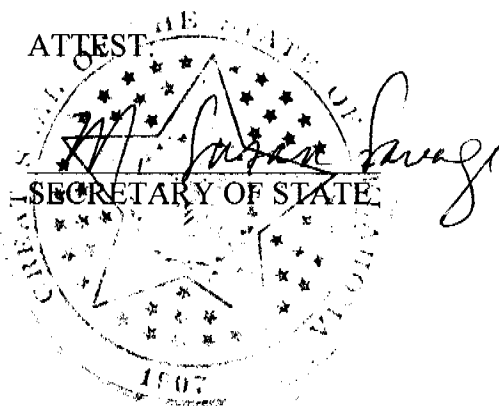
This Executive Order shall be forwarded to the Director of the Office of Personnel Management who shall cause the provisions of this order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government.

EXECUTIVE ORDER 2006-32

On December 28, 2006, George W. Bush, President of the United States, issued a Proclamation and an Executive Order declaring Tuesday, January 2, 2007, as a National Day of Mourning and closing certain federal offices throughout the United States to pay homage to the memory of President Gerald R. Ford, the thirty-eighth President of the United States

I, Brad Henry, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, pursuant to the power vested in me under the provisions of Section 82.1 of Title 25 of the Oklahoma Statutes, hereby declare Tuesday, January 2, 2007, a holiday and Day of Mourning in the State of Oklahoma. All official business in the State of Oklahoma on Tuesday, January 2, 2007, shall be suspended while our state and nation mourn the death of President Gerald R. Ford. Appointing Authorities who are responsible for facilities or programs that require 24-hour operation should arrange appropriate staffing consistent with policies and procedures used for other State holidays.

This Executive Order shall be forwarded to the Secretary for Human Resources and Administration who shall cause the provisions of this order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government. Copies of this Executive Order shall be supplied to each Cabinet Secretary.
