An Act relating to education; amending Section 6 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2007 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature, as amended by Section 4 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2012 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to appropriations; modifying amount of appropriation; amending Sections 7 and 15 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2012 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature, which relate to appropriations; modifying allocation of funds; deleting requirement to transfer certain funds; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 6 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2007 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature, as amended by Section 4 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2012 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, the sum of ~~One Hundred Fifty-seven Million Four Hundred Sixty-four Thousand Eight Hundred Forty Dollars (\$157,464,840.00)~~ One Hundred Fifty-five Million Four Hundred Sixty-four Thousand Eight Hundred Forty Dollars (\$155,464,840.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the support of public school activities.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 7 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2012 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 7. Beginning July 1, 2004, the support of public school activities by the State Board of Education payable from monies appropriated and authorized by Sections 3, 4 and 7 through 11 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2007 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature and Sections 1 through 6 of ~~this act~~ Enrolled House Bill No. 2012 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature shall be apportioned as follows:

1. Funds appropriated and authorized by Sections 3 and 4 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2007 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature and Sections 1, 2, 3 and 5 of ~~this act~~ Enrolled House Bill No. 2012 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature:

SECTION 3. AMENDATORY Section 15 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2012 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:


Section 15. The funds allocated in Section 7 of ~~this act~~ Enrolled House Bill No. 2012 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature and Section 2 of this act for Staff Development are provided for teacher training, in-service teacher education and staff development plans. The sum of Seven Hundred Seventy-one Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty-six Dollars (\$771,756.00) shall provide for scholarships to the Great Expectations Summer Institutes for Teachers offered by an institution within The Oklahoma State System

of Higher Education pursuant to Section 6-194.2 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes. From the funds provided for the Great Expectations Summer Institutes for Teachers, the State Board of Education shall establish an elementary level Great Expectations Demonstration Project. The Project shall be established at an elementary school in the state which is participating in the Great Expectations Program and has shown significant progress while under that Program. The sum of Two Million Five Hundred Twenty-nine Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-eight Dollars (\$2,529,978.00) shall be transferred to the Professional Development Institutes Revolving Fund created in Section 6-204.5 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes and shall be expended for the purpose of developing, offering and administering professional development institutes in reading for elementary school teachers as directed in Section 6-200 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The sum of Four Million One Hundred Three Thousand Four Hundred Four Dollars (\$4,103,404.00) shall be used for costs associated with multiple ongoing assessments and remediation as contained in Section 1210.508D of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The sum of Nine Hundred Seventy-seven Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-two Dollars (\$977,762.00) shall be used to provide a comprehensive professional development program for teachers and other school personnel on neurodevelopmentally based student learning differences. The program shall provide research-based knowledge and skills training to help educators recognize, understand and manage students with differences in learning. The Board shall select a public, private, or nonprofit provider on a competitive bid basis to conduct the program. The sum of Three Hundred Nine Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-eight Dollars (\$309,558.00) shall be used to continue research-based professional development for teachers through the Child Service Demonstration Center. ~~The sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) shall be transferred to the Mathematics Improvement Program Revolving Fund as created in Section 2 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 911 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature to be used to implement the Mathematics Improvement Program pursuant to Enrolled Senate Bill No. 911 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature.~~ The sum of Sixty-three Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-five Dollars (\$63,785.00) shall be expended for the purpose of expanding the number of elementary schools which utilize the Oklahoma A+ Schools Art Program offered through an institution within the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education. The remainder shall be allocated on an average daily attendance basis for the purpose of teacher education staff development pursuant to rules established by the State Board of Education. Five percent (5%) of the funds allocated by average daily attendance for Staff Development may be used by local districts for the administration of the staff development program.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2004.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.


