An Act relating to education; amending Sections 1 and 2 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1020 of the 1st Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature, which relate to appropriations to the State Board of Education; modifying funding amounts; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1020 of the 1st Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, the sum of ~~One Billion One Hundred Seventy-six Million Seven Hundred Eighty-one Thousand Ten Dollars~~ ~~(\$1,176,781,010.00)~~ One Billion One Hundred Seventy-seven Million Two Hundred Eighty-five Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-five Dollars (\$1,177,285,775.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of public schools.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 2 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1020 of the 1st Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Education Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 41.29b of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the sum of ~~Four Hundred Seventy Million Six Hundred Ninety-five Thousand Twenty-eight Dollars~~ ~~(\$470,695,028.00)~~ Four Hundred Seventy Million One Hundred Ninety Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-three Dollars (\$470,190,263.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of public schools.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
