An Act relating to the State Board of Education; making appropriations to the State Board of Education; stating purposes; making appropriations nonfiscal; making appropriations exempt from certain agency category and budget limits; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Three Hundred Eighty-seven Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$387,725.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, which shall be transferred to the Oklahoma National Board Certification Revolving Fund created in Section 6-204.4 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes for the purpose of awarding annual bonuses as directed.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Twelve Million Ten Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-six Dollars (\$12,010,266.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the Certified Employee Health Benefit Allowance.


SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Two Million Eight Hundred Twenty Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-nine Dollars (\$2,820,949.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the Support Personnel Health Benefit Allowance.

SECTION 4. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.


SECTION 5. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal years 2005 and 2006 agency category and budget limits.

SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.


